Chocolate Factory Martini

Tanqueray Gin, Dry Vermouth, White Chocolate, Lavender

In 1909 Keizersgracht 224 was turned into a chocolate factory. During this renovation, the monumental staircases and reception were completely spoiled. With this drink, we remember our history, the good and the bad, but always with a smooth and delicate ending.

Amarena Manhattan

Dark Rum, Woodford Reserve Bourbon, Sweet Vermouth,
Amarena Cherry, Coconut

In the late 18th Century Keizersgracht 224 was purchased by a wealthy dye and indigo merchant. In a letter we found we discovered that his wife's favourite dye was dark red, the same colour as the delicious and sour Amarena cherry.

Golden Fields Fashioned

Inactive Yeast Genever, Coffee infused Michter's Rye, Banana, Bitters 15

In 1615 a rich barley merchant, going by the name of Jan Egbertsz, purchased Keizersgracht 222 and 224. He named the house "De drie vergulde akkers", meaning the three golden fields. This cocktail is our ode to grain and its versatility.

Leather Negroni

Roku Gin, Barolo Chinato, Oloroso Sherry, Campari, Leather & Dry Essence

The beautiful nine streets surrounding our hotel used to be the epicentre of the Amsterdam leather trade. We have created a cocktail that will take you back to those heydays. Harsh as fresh leather but delicate as mature fruit.

Rose Garden Margarita

Rose Petal infused Don Julio Blanco, Apricot, Lime, Peychaud's Bitters 15

In 1635 Maria Fassijn bought Keizersgracht 236, the current home of Pulitzer's Bar. Maria created a beautiful rose garden between her front and back house. The garden isn't here anymore, but with this drink we revive the memory of blooming roses and peaceful garden walks.

Back House Mary

Ketel One Vodka, Fermented Tomato, Celery, Spice 15

Winters were cold and food was scarce in the Golden Age in Amsterdam. Staff would be instructed to stock up for the winter months and ferment fruit and vegetables to preserve the valuable food. This twist on a Bloody Mary uses old techniques and applies them in a modern way.

Brave & Stormy

Rum Blend, Pineapple, Hops & Ginger 15

In the late 18th Century Jan de Neufville, owner of Keizersgracht 236 and a famous Amsterdam banker, set sail to America. Same as for the cocktail, he takes the risk in search of a bigger fortune, ready to lose it all.

Peperbael Paloma

Pink Peppercorn Patron, Grapefruit, Soda 15

In 1621 Hans Lenaertsz, owner of the spice shop "Peperbael", buys Keizersgracht 222 and 224 and turns the plot name into the now well known Saxenburg House. Just the same as his spice shop, the Paloma is a discovery of flavours and senses, ready to be explored.



Sauternes, Ketel One Citroen, Camomile infused Pineau, Lemon, Orange Flower & Almond Essence, Prosecco 15
